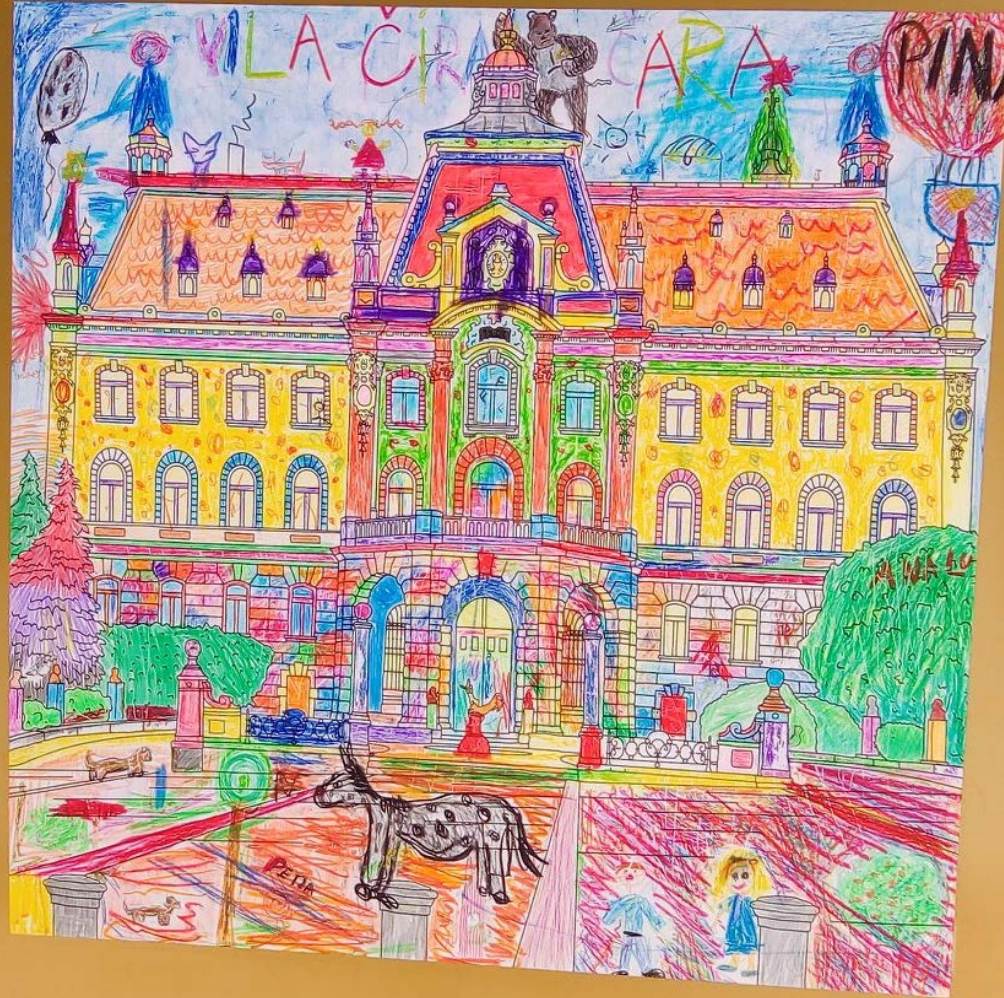

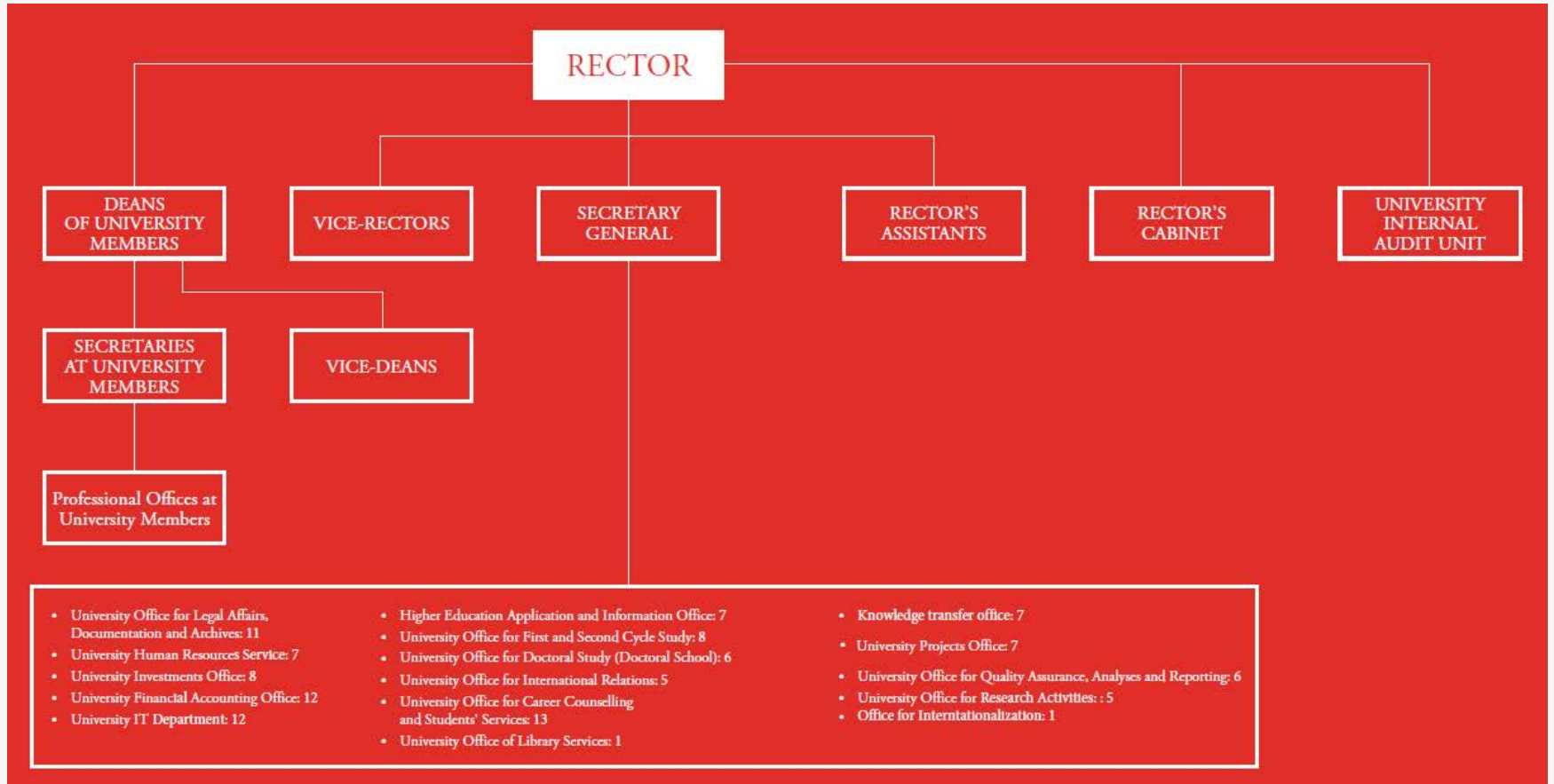

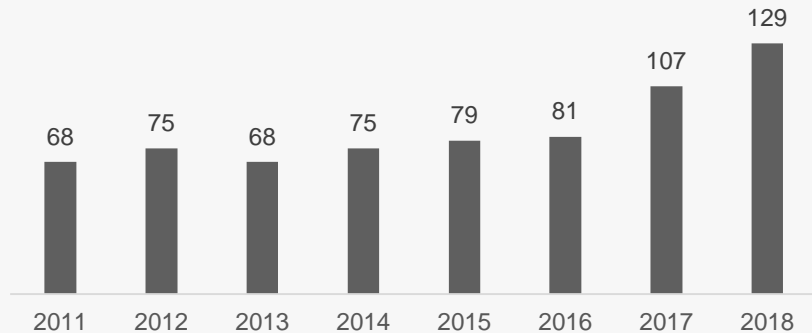
Foreign teachers and researchers

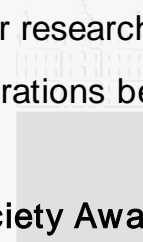

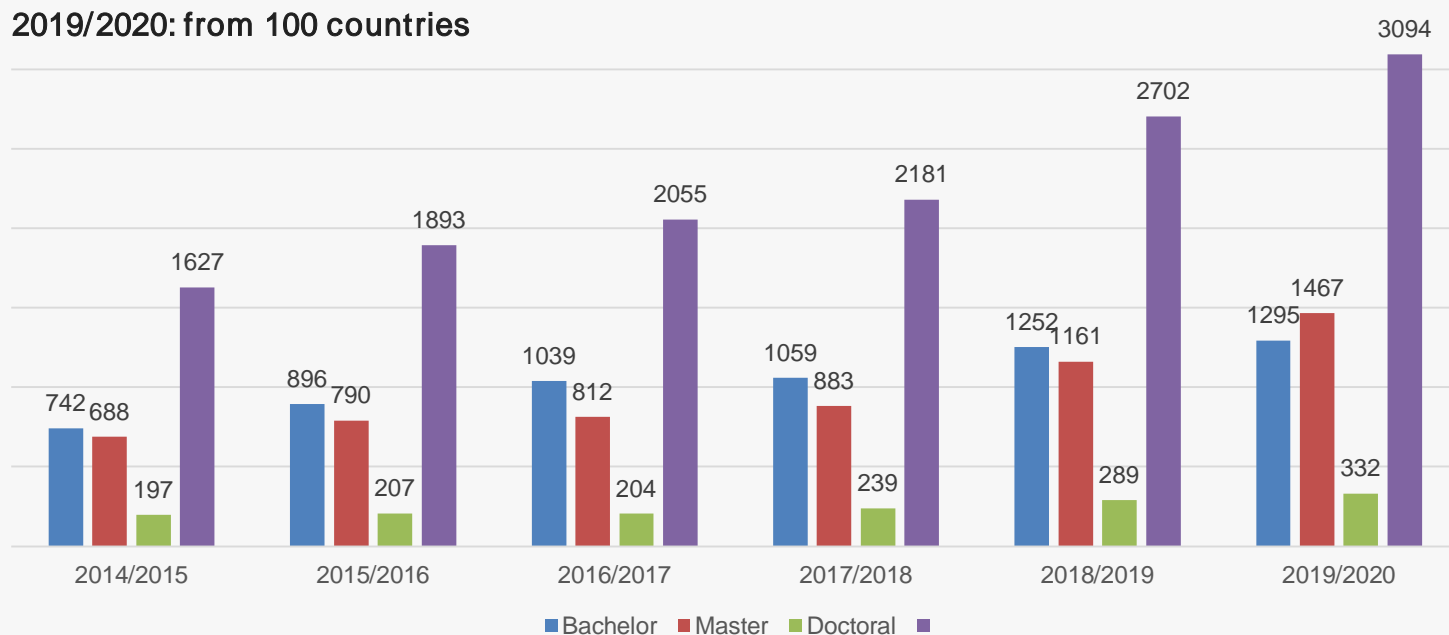

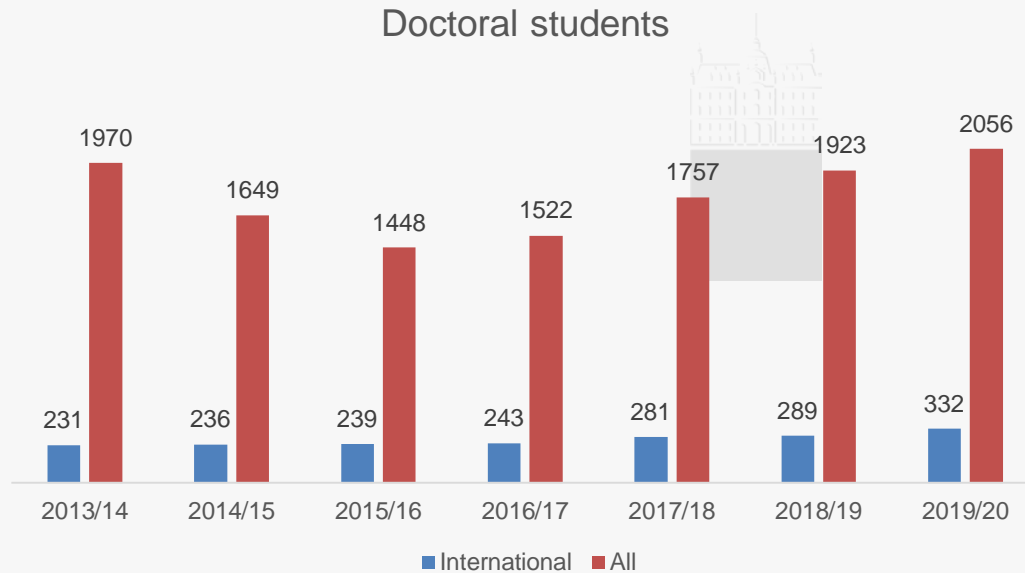
2019/2020: from 100 countries

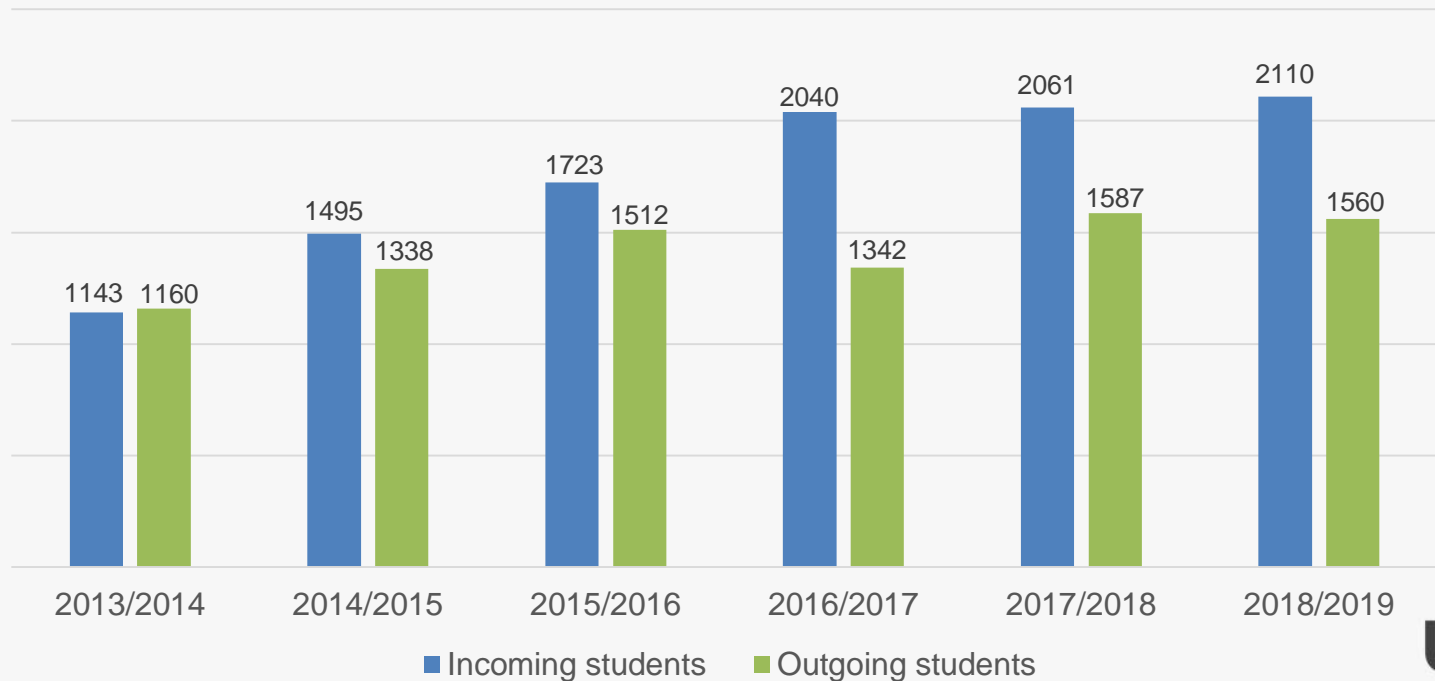

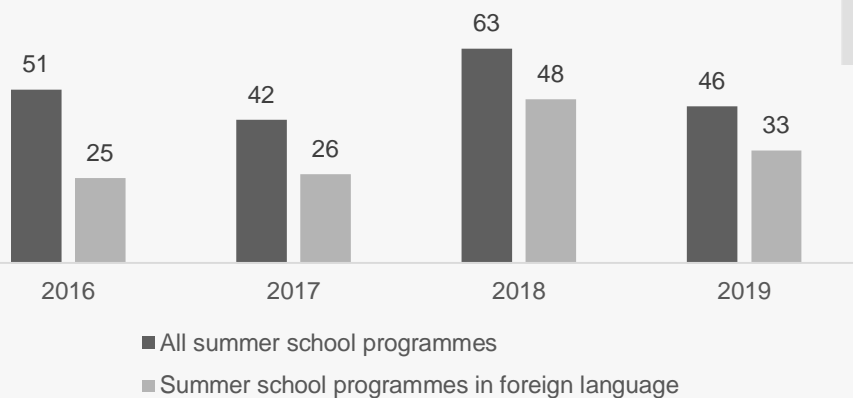

Студентите од Северна Македонија студираат под истите услови како и словенечките студенти

„Година плус“ е склоп на содржини и предмети (покрај задолжителниот словенечки јазик) кој по исполнувањето на одредените услови им овозможува на странските студенти да го продолжат статусот на студент

Оваа година Универзитетот во Љубљана прославува сто години работење и е најголем и најстар универзитет во Словенија. На Универзитетот студираат 37.700 студенти, од кои 3.122 се странски. Најголем број од нив доаѓаат од Северна Македонија 700 (наведените бројни податоци уште не се официјални и може да бидат променети). Во светски рамки Универзитетот во Љубљана спаѓа во трите проценти најдобри на светот. На 23 факултети и 3 уметнички академии се нудат студии од областите на општествените

науки, хуманистиката, природните науки, медицината, техниката и уметноста, што е реткост дури и на светско ниво.

Словенија и Северна Македонија имаат направено меѓудржавен договор врз основа на кој студентите од Северна Македонија се ослободени од плаќање школарина, освен ако веќе имаат стекнато еквивалентен степен на образование. Школарината е задолжителна и за сите воредни студенти и за студентите на докторските студии. „Во Словенија имаме уредено кофинансирање на јавно признати доктор-

ски студиски програми. Сите студенти мораат да ги платат трошоците за упис и можните придонеси. Податоците за висината на школарината се достапни на веб-страницата на Универзитетот во Љубљана www.uni-lj.si/study“ објасни ректорот на Универзитетот во Љубљана, проф. д-р Игор Папич.

Година плус за странските студенти

Во споредба со другите држави, студентите во Словенија имаат одредени поволности. Имаат субвен-

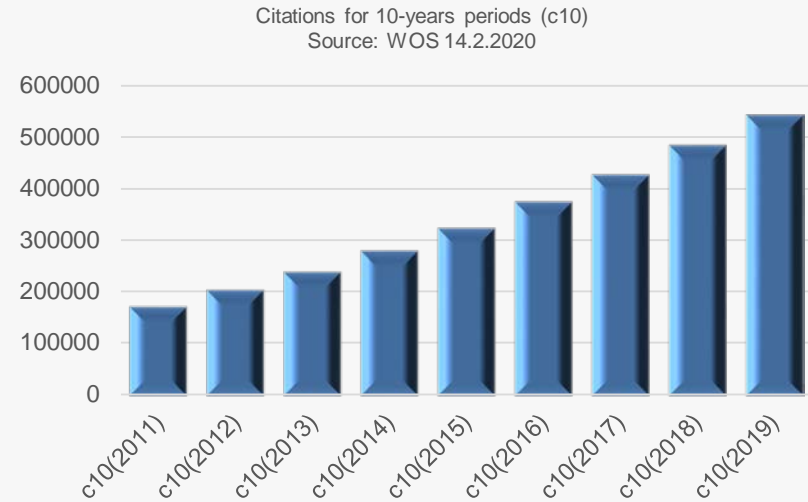

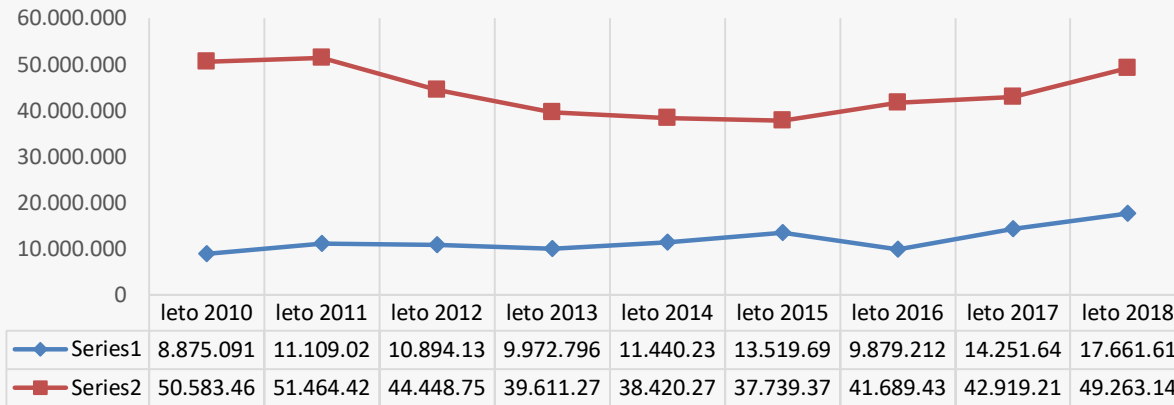

UL R&D PUBLIC EXPENDITURE IN THE PERIOD 2009-2018

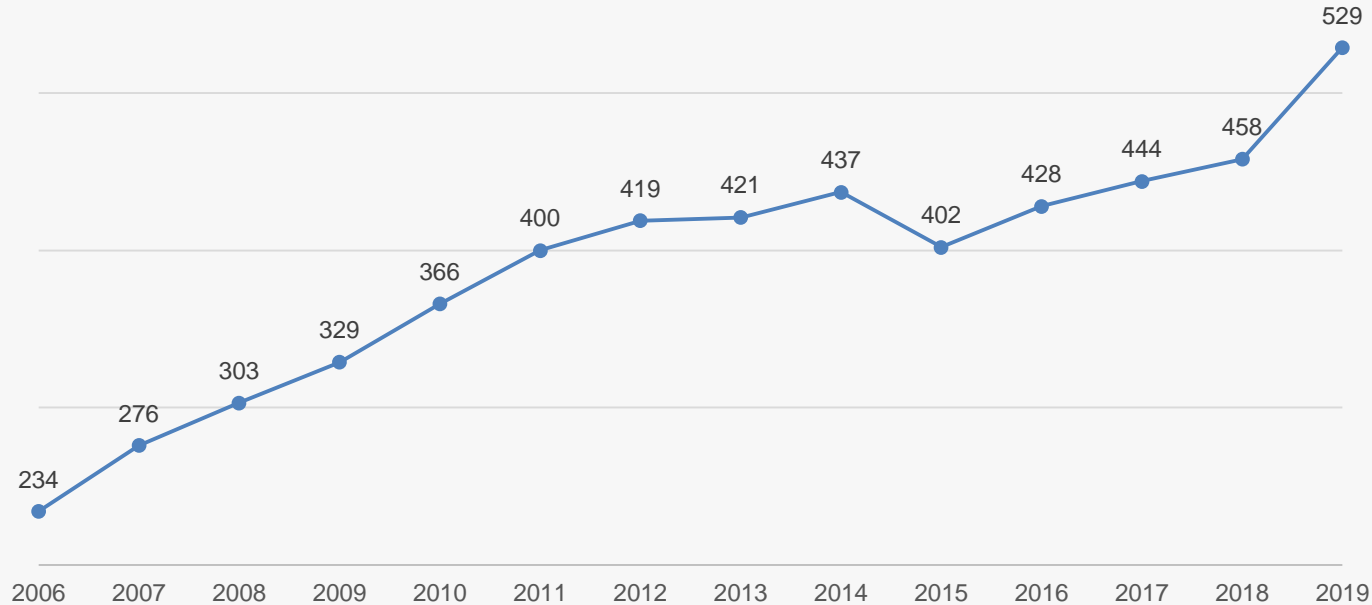

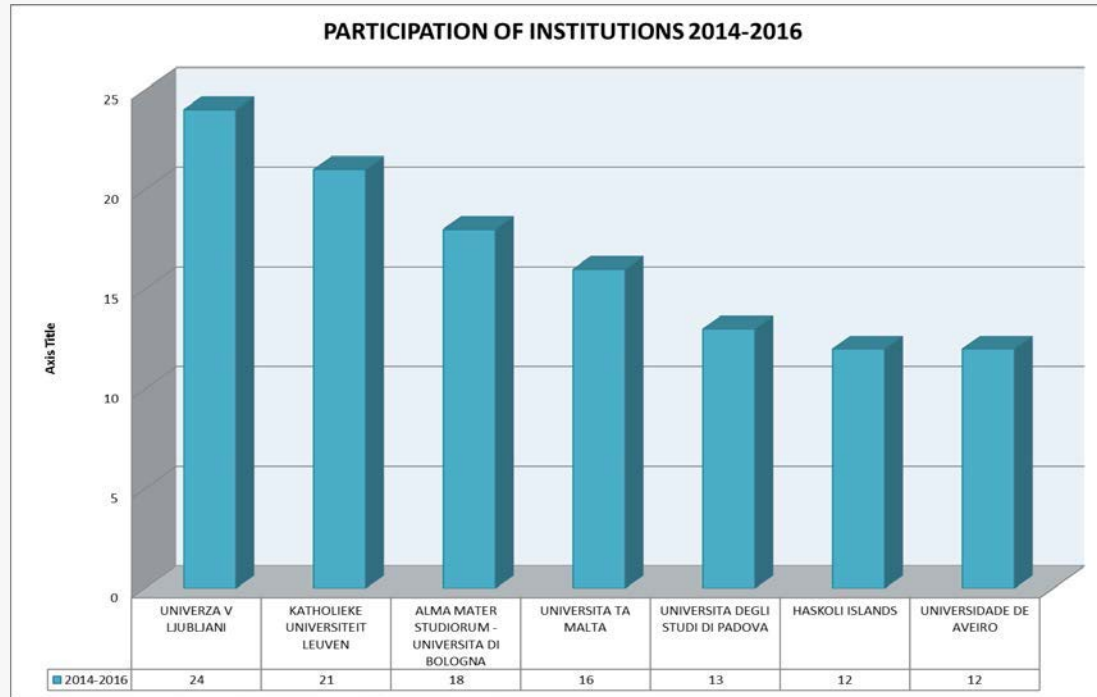

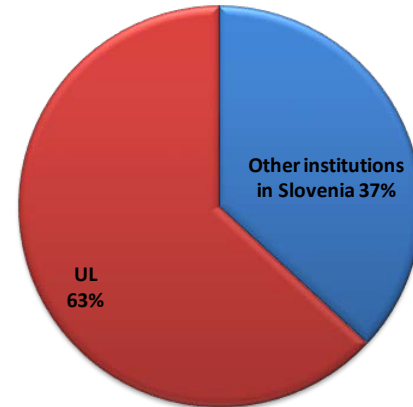

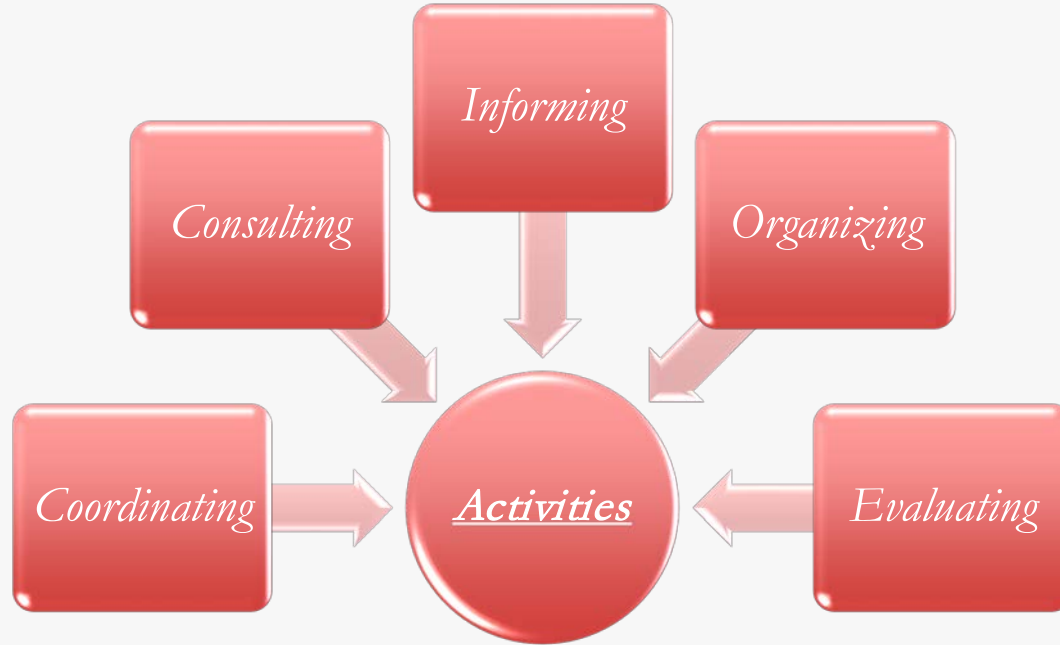
University Office for Research

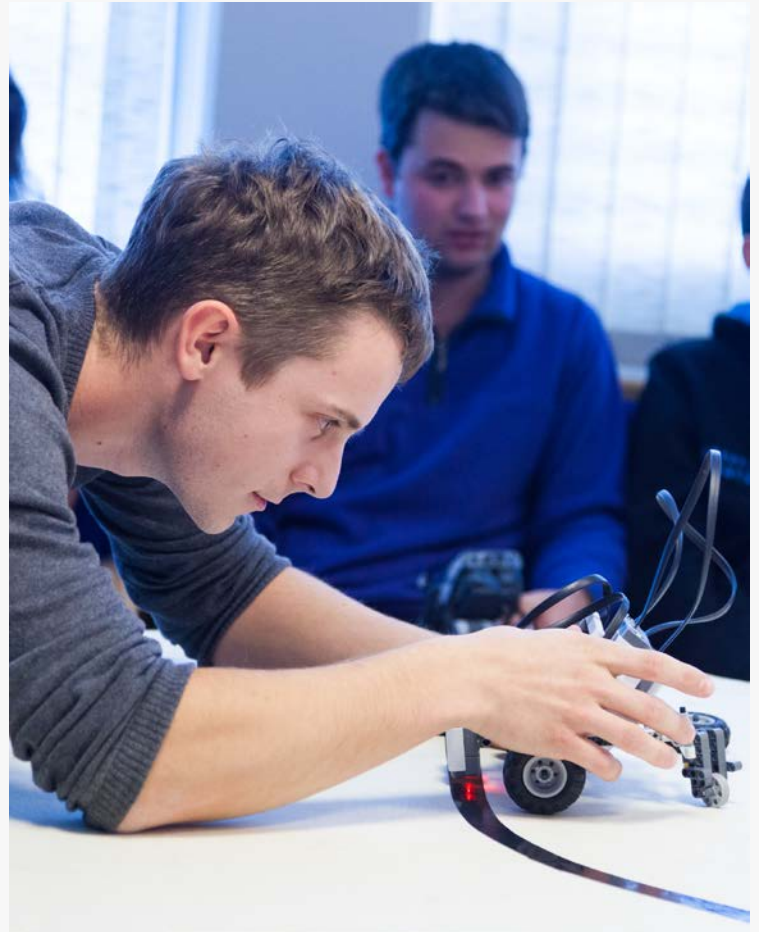

Faculties have to send the contracts to be signed by the rector with the Dean's letter.

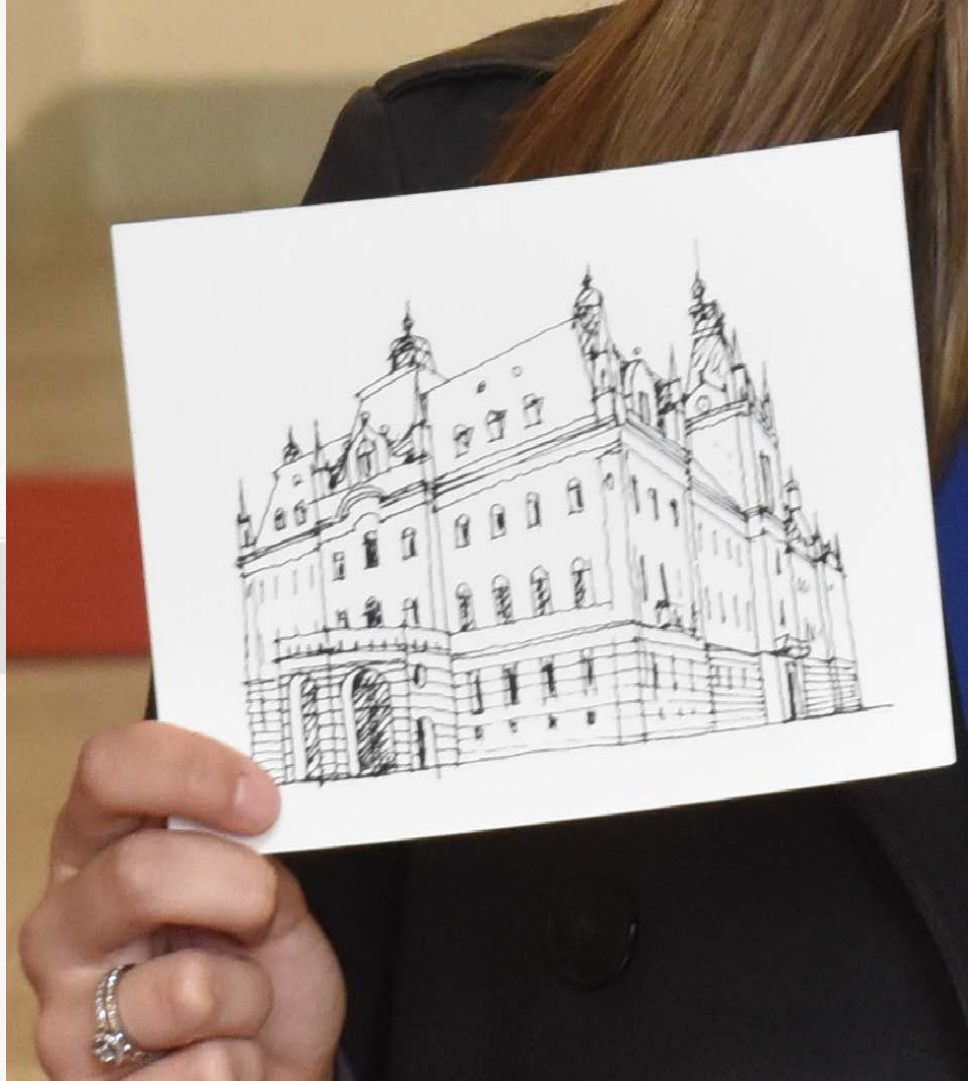

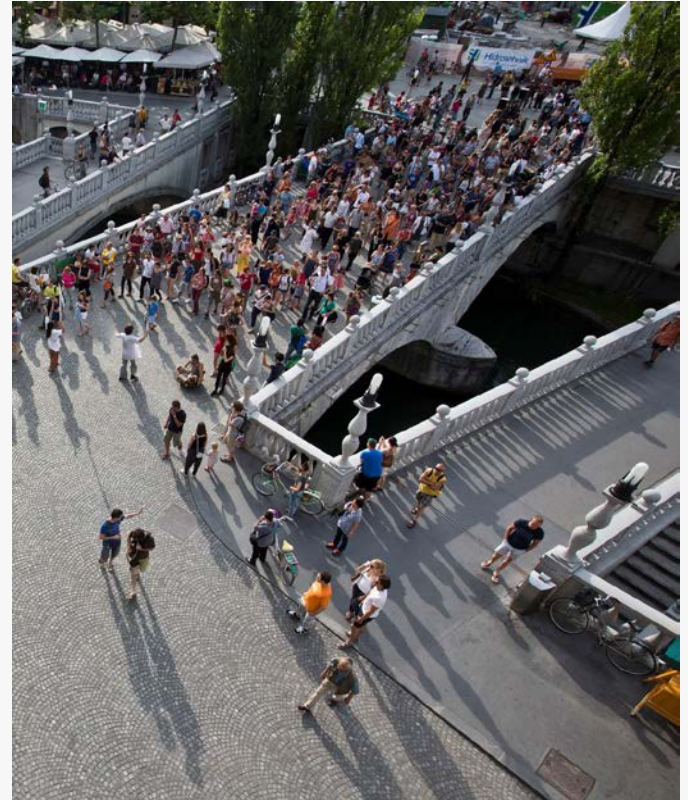

Useful tips:

- use every opportunity to promote the mobility programmes,
- use innovative approaches/social media for motivating and informing students,
- include teachers as much as possible (for motivating the students and colleagues, for academic preparation, monitoring, and reintegration of outgoing students, for dissemination of the results),
- set up a tutoring system for incoming students (academic and student buddies),
- cooperate close with Student Organisation /ESN,
- maintain your website regularly (in local and English language),
- set up a good IT support system,
- prepare and publish FAQ,
- prepare and publish timetable of procedures for outgoing students,
- offer accommodation support for incoming students,
- cooperate close with embassies and administration units,
- include incoming students into all activities, available for domestic students.

Good cooperation and daily contact with departmental Erasmus+ coordinators is vital!

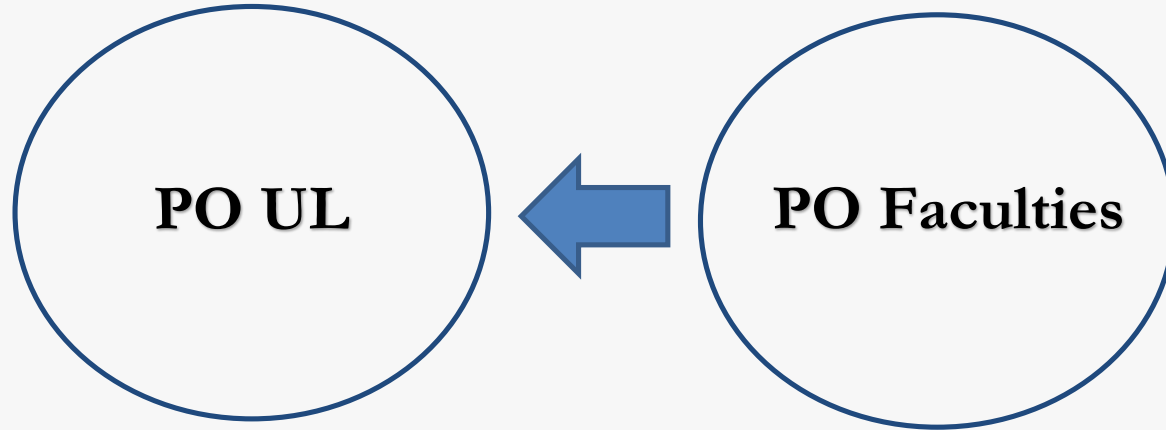

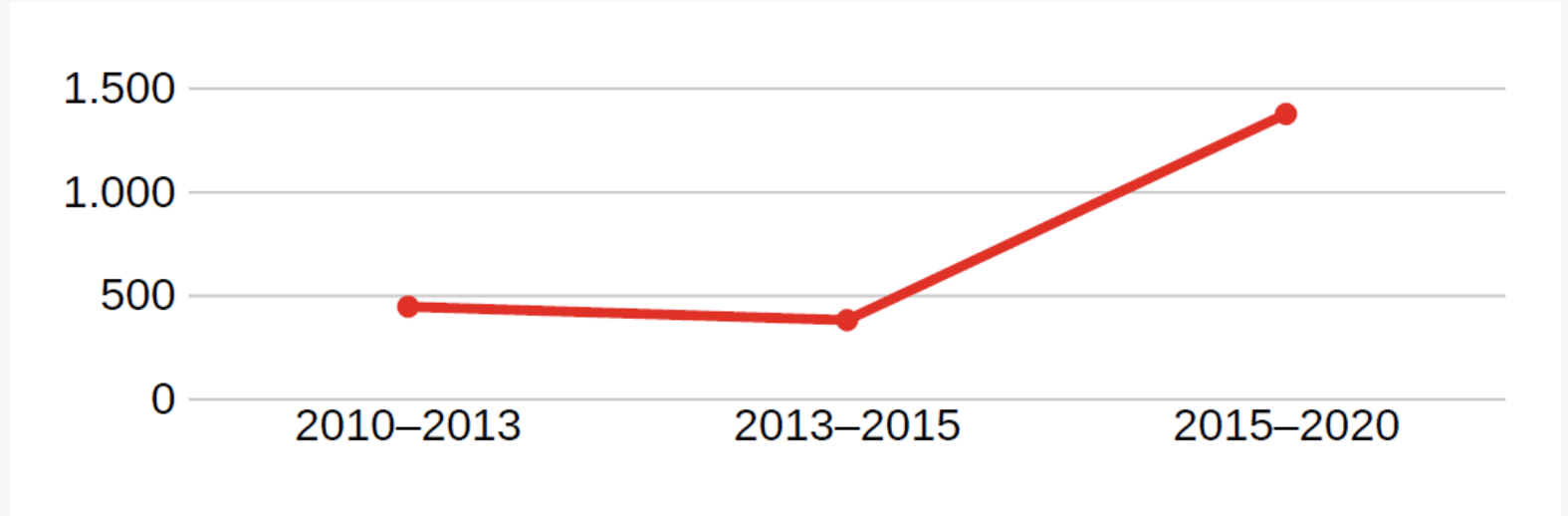


Number of individual consultations



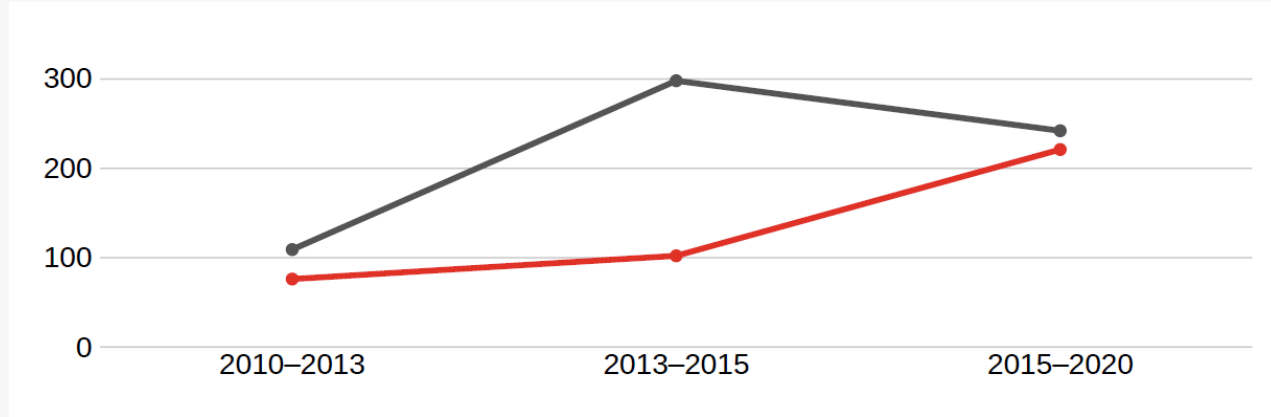

Univerza v Ljubljani



Univerza v Ljubljani pridobila že peti ERC projekt

Trenutno je v Sloveniji aktivnih šest ERC projektov, od tega štiri na Univerzi v Ljubljani; kar dva na Fakulteti za strojništvo.

Ljubljana, 27. julija 2018 – Danes je izjavila agencija Evropskega raziskovalnega sveta (ERCEA) objavila rezultate zadnjega razpisa ERC Starting Grant 2018, na katerega je pripilo 3170 projektov predlogov najodličnejših raziskovalcev in raziskovalcev z vsega sveta. Odobreni so 403 vloge v vredni več kot 600 mio evrov. Med uspešnimi prijavitelji je tudi slovenski raziskovalec v Univerze v Ljubljani doc. dr. Jaka Tušek s projektom **SUPERCOOL - Superelastic porous structures for efficient elastocaloric cooling** (Superelastične porozne strukture za učinkovito elastokalorično hlajenje), za izvedbo katerega bo prejel 1,4 mio evrov.

Doc. dr. Jaka Tušek je raziskovalec v Laboratoriju za hlajenje in daljinsko energetiko (LAHDE) na Fakulteti za strojništvo Univerze v Ljubljani, ki je v manj kot letu dni pridobila št. dva ERC projekta. Doc. dr. Tušek je na intervjuju v Reviji predsedal 14-danški panel vrhunskih znanstvenikov s področja naravoslovesnih znanosti. S projektom, ki je vreden 1,4 mio evrov, bo vzpostavil svojo prvo samostojno raziskovalno skupino, v kateri bo pet let zaposlenih šest raziskovalcev.

Predmet raziskave bodo ključni elementi **elastokalorične** hladilne tehnologije, ki so iterativni ocenah kaže največji potencial kot alternativa dandanes široko uporabne **parociklične** tehnologije hlajenja. Ta je kljub več kot stoletnemu razvoju še vedno relativno lahko energetsko učinkovita in ekološko oporna. Končni cilj projekta je razviti **elastokalorično** hladilno napravo, ki bi lahko predstavljala prvi večji preboj na področju hlajenja v zadnji sto letih z večjo učinkovitostjo ter manjšim onesnaženjem okolja. Ob uspešnem razvoju bo predlagan koncept hlajenja lahko široko uporabljen na različnih področjih hladilne tehnike, vse od miniaturnega hlajenja do velikih hladilnih sistemov in toplotnih črpalk.

Elastokalorično hlajenje temelji na **elastokaloričnem** učinku, ki ga zaznamo kot segrevanje in ohlajanje **supersustojljivih** materialov z običavnim sponkanjem. Cilj projekta **SUPERCOOL** je prenesti dva ključna izraza **elastokalorične** tehnologije hlajenja »Prvi izvir je razvoj **supersustojljivih** oz. **elastokaloričnih** struktur, torej ključnega elementa **elastokaloričnega** hladilnega sistema, ki bo zagotavljala dovolj dolgo življenjsko dobo in mehansko stabilnost ter hitre in učinkovite prenose toplote. Drugi izvir je razvoj kompleksnega in učinkovitega pogonskega sistema za obremenjevanje **elastokaloričnih** struktur, ki bo omogočilo tudi učinkovito izrabo energije. Predlagan koncept **elastokalorične** tehnologije hlajenja bo lahko uporabljen ob miniaturnega hlajenja (na primer za hlajenje elektronskih komponent), hladilnih naprav, pa vse do velikih hladilnih sistemov in toplotnih črpalk. Pomembno odkritje mehanskih povezav med bakterijami

Temeljno naravoslovnno odkritje raziskovalcev Univerze v Ljubljani omogoča novo razumevanje bakterijskega sodelovanja, komuniciranja in njihovega vpliva na okolje

Ljubljana, 25. oktobra 2017 – Skupina raziskovalcev v Univerze v Ljubljani je odkrila mehanske povezave med bakterijami, za katere je veljalo, da ne obstajajo. Raziskovalci so prvi opazili, da se celice v suspenziji povežejo v nevtrino mrežo, prek katere sledijo gibanju optično ujetih bakterij. Za vidno bakterijsko strukturo se skriva nevtrina mreža medceličnih povezav, ki predstavlja **do sedaj** nevtrino tkano organizma.

Vse od definicije planktona leta 1860 so bili raziskovalci prepričani, da se gibanje bakterij **previdno** določeno v tokom okolice vode, kjer celice nimajo medceličnih povezav in se prostje gibljejo neodvisno druga od druge. Raziskovalci v Univerze v Ljubljani so nedavno dokazali, da **prav** ni tako. »*Prilike povzročajo med bakterijskimi celicami in v planktonu občilke prisilne, vendar jih v standardnem mikrobiološkem okolju ni mogoče opaziti. Mrežne mreže lahko posredujejo celice v nepredvidljivi bakterijski suspenziji vidno in prelojeno, je njihovo povezanje mogoče dokazati tudi v celinski suspenziji ene ali več celic, ki jih v medceličnem komunikaciji je ob pomembnem odkritju povelja vodila skupina raziskovalcev prof. dr. David Starop in Biološki Univerze v Ljubljani. Da bi to potrdili, so raziskovalci uporabili optično pinseto in kot prvi opazili, da se celice v suspenziji povežejo v nevtrino mrežo, prek katere sledijo gibanju optično ujetih bakterije. Za vidno bakterijsko strukturo se tako skriva nevtrina mreža medceličnih povezav, ki predstavlja **do sedaj** nevtrino tkano organizma.*

Raziskava je pokazala, da so bile mehanske povezave prisotne pri nizkih gostotah bakterij, kar je v ostrem nasprotju s trenutno sprejetim modelom, da se mešanje bakterij pojavi šele pri visokih gostotah, pri preobodu v t. i. biofilm. *»Mehanične povezave, ki omogočajo skupno preverjanje bakterij, so razvidne od stitih, ki jih najdemo v bijskih. Zelo pomembno se nakazuje, da, ki opredeljuje interakcije in sposobnosti novega bakterijskega organizma, omogočajo samo-organiziranje tkane celic. Če je mreža mreže ustrezna, je mogoče opaziti mrežo v nova okolja. Tako poleg naša v vsakdanjem življenju naša mreža lahko kaže kot različno stanje, poljanje Starop.*

Bakterije so glede na rezultate raziskave sposobne izdelati dobro povezano mikrobrno tkivo na dolge razdalje (naš več kot 100 μ m). To je presenetljivo, pravi Starop, saj je **do sedaj** veljalo, da so asociativni organizmi v suspenziji med seboj nepovezani. »Medobna povezanost je bila vedno manj vidje stopnje razvoja, razsvetljena za večinske organizme, podobno. A določ raziskovalci na tem mestu še ni končano. Odkritje tkane **elastokalorične** zunanjoobna bakterijske mreže je prineslo dodatna vprašanja o delovanju bakterij v suspenziji, kar pa omogoča relevantne nakladi temeljnih mikrobioloških **preiskovanj**, ki so vezani na medcelično komunikacijo bakterijskih celic in njihovo odzivnost na spremembe v svoji.

Raziskovalci v Univerze v Ljubljani so ugotovili, da bakterije še niso tako osamljene, kot se je zdelo. Rezultati raziskave so upravičeni pogled na naše dojemane bakterij kot osamljenih samostalnih celic, ki se družijo zgoj.

Velik mejnik na področju ekologije letalskih prevozov

Študenti Univerze v Ljubljani s podjetjem Pipistrel razvili prvo polnilnico za elektrifika letala na svetu

Ljubljana, 18. oktobra 2017 - Uspešno sodelovanje med Univerzo v Ljubljani in gospodarstvom je pripeljalo do... izdelave stacionarne polnilne postaje za elektrifika letala, ki ima zaradi svojega delovanja tudi pozitiven družbeni in okoljski učinek. Konec avgusta so tako na sedežu podjetja Pipistrel zagnali prvo elektrifika polnilnico za letala na svetu, ki zdaj že čaka na serijsko proizvodnjo.

V sklopu projekta **Podjetje prvi do praksičnega opreza** so pod mentorstvom asist. dr. Vanje Cok s Fakultete za strojništvo Univerze v Ljubljani, razvojnega inženirja Aljaša Pelcača ter inženirja programske opreme Čira Gorupa (oba Pipistrel), študenti taksi člane Univerze v Ljubljani Fakultete za strojništvo, Palenčeta za računalništvo in informatiko in Alkašenarja v Alkašenarja in obkroženje v sodelovanju s podjetjem Pipistrel razvili prototip prve elektrifika polnilnice za letala. Cilj projekta je bila izdelava in povratitev polnilnice za elektrifika letala, saj se je pri polnjenju elektrifika letal v praksi pokazala potreba po stacionarnem načinu polnjenja.

Letenje s elektrifikimi letali prinosa številne prednosti (brez emisij, nižji onesnaženje in hrupom, nižji stroški letenja) in sorpada s cilji **Evropske Unije** na področju transporta in letarstva, saj so v dolgotrajnem programu Oborota 2020 Pamenen in okolju prijazen promet med najpomembnejšimi smernicami tudi zmanjšanje hrupa ter zniževanje emisij v letalskem prometu. Razvoj in povratitev mreže stacionarnih polnilnih postaj je pomemben korak k povečanju priljubljenosti in razširjenosti letal v okolju, predvsem pa povečuje ekološko ozaveščenost pilotov in pomikov. Prva polnilnica za elektrifika letala predstavlja velik mejnik na področju ekologije letalskih prevozov.

Sodelovanje med univerzo in gospodarstvom ključno za soustvarjanje novih znanj in praktičnih rešitev

Povezovanje znanosti in gospodarstva je za največje univerzo v Sloveniji ključnega pomena. Namen trenutnega povezovanja je učinkovite in aktualne prenosi znanj in spoznanj v gospodarstvo in hudo družbo. Študenti Univerze v Ljubljani so tako sklopu projekta razvili postajo, nort izdelali v inženirskem timu. Pri razvoju polnilnice so uporabili znanje, ki so ga pridobili pri študijskih predmetih, dodano vrednost pa je imela temeljna raziskava obstoječega stanja v prvi razvojni fazi projekta, kar so presušili širok nabor informacij (od psihologije uporabnika, ergonomije, tehničnih specifikacij, zakonodajne, programske opreme, elektrotehnikne, vremenikih vplovov, različnih in drugo), ki **sodelovanjem** na projektu **in naši študenti pridobijo izkušnje v ustvari stroke, razvijajo kompetence na svojem strokovnem področju, pridobijo različne mentorstvenje, določijo skupno skupino, ki je sprejela, kako lahko na **področju** naših raziskav tehnične težnje. » je dalo i študenti na projektu optični asist. dr. Mednarodni dan žensk in deklet v znanosti

11. februar na Univerzi v Ljubljani že peto leto zapored obeležujejo Mednarodni dan žensk in deklet v znanosti. Razveseljivo je, da na Univerzi v Ljubljani na vseh treh stopnjah študija prevladujejo ženske. Slovenija pa se, glede na zadnje podatke Eurostata, po deležu žensk v znanosti med 34 evropskimi državami uvršča na 17. mesto in med 27 članicami Evropske unije na 14. mesto.

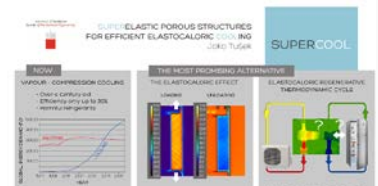
Univerza v Ljubljani kot najstarejša visokošolska izobraževalna institucija v Sloveniji nazorno prikazuje preobrazbo slovenske družbe v odnosu do žolajev žensk. V prvem inštitutnem letu, 1919/1920, je bilo med študenti tri odsto žensk in 97 odstotkov moških. Preden let kameje je bilo razmerje še blizu izenačitvi, in sicer 48 odstotkov žensk in 52 odstotkov moških. V sedemdesetih letih je bilo razmerje med študentkami in študenti približno izenačeno; v študijskem letu 1978/1979 je znašalo natančno pol-pol. V osemdesetih letih so med študenti začele prevladovati ženske; zadnjih 20 let se razmerje med študentkami in študenti vrta okoli 60 proti 40.

Drugegače pa so števila, ko se od študija preselimo na področje akademske kariere. Med raziskovalkami/raziskovalci ter visokoškolskimi učiteljicami/učitelji in sodelavkami/sodelavci je sto let prevladujejo moški. Razmerje zadnjih deset let je v povprečju 60 proti 40 odstotkov v korist moških.

«Leta 2018 je bilo med docentkami/docenti 56 odstotkov moških, med izrednimi in rednimi profesorjicami/profesorji pa je še vedno večina moških – 60 odstotkov izrednih profesorjev in 69 odstotkov rednih profesorjev, ugotovila prof. dr. Aleksandra Kanjuz Mrčeta, prednožna doktorica sole na Univerzi v Ljubljani in profesorica sociologije na Fakulteti za družbene vede Univerze v Ljubljani. A razmere se vendarle počasi izboljšujejo. »V zadnjih letih se udeležba moških zmanjšuje v vseh skupinah visokošolskih učiteljev in pričakovani je, da bo v naslednjem obdobju struktura po spolu uravnotežena v vseh vrstah.»

Znanstveniki že več kot dveletje glasno opozarjajo na nujnost odločneje ukrepanja proti podnebnim spremembam, saj je po njihovih ugotovitvah danajši način življenja nezdržljiv z dolgoročnim obstojem civilizacije, kot je poznamo danes. Znanstveni računalniški modeli preizkušajo različne scenarije za prihodno in zelo se trudijo, da bi uspeli doseči zastavljene cilje glede omejitve drvig temperature. Vendar bo za uspešno potrebno usklajeno delovanje vseh dejavnikov. Zato so raziskave, ki so usmerjene v zmanjševanje okoljske škode, vredne v pozornosti. Lahko bi rekli, da med te sodi tudi raziskava doc. dr. Jake Tuške Fakultete za strojništvo (FS) Univerze v Ljubljani (UL). Sam pravi, da raziskuje in razvija tehnologijo, ki naj bi služila človeštvu. Razvijal bo elastokalorično hladilno napravo, ki bo biuroveno zmanjšala onesnaževanje okolja v primerjavi z obstoječimi napravami.

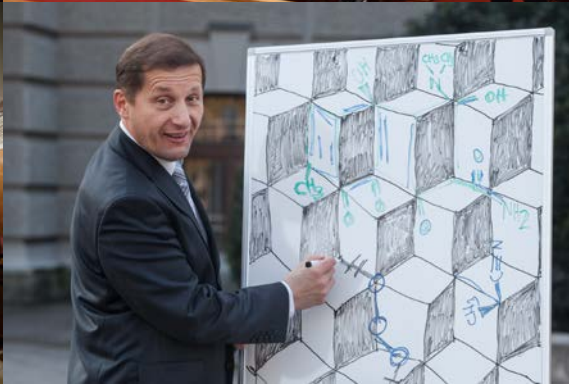

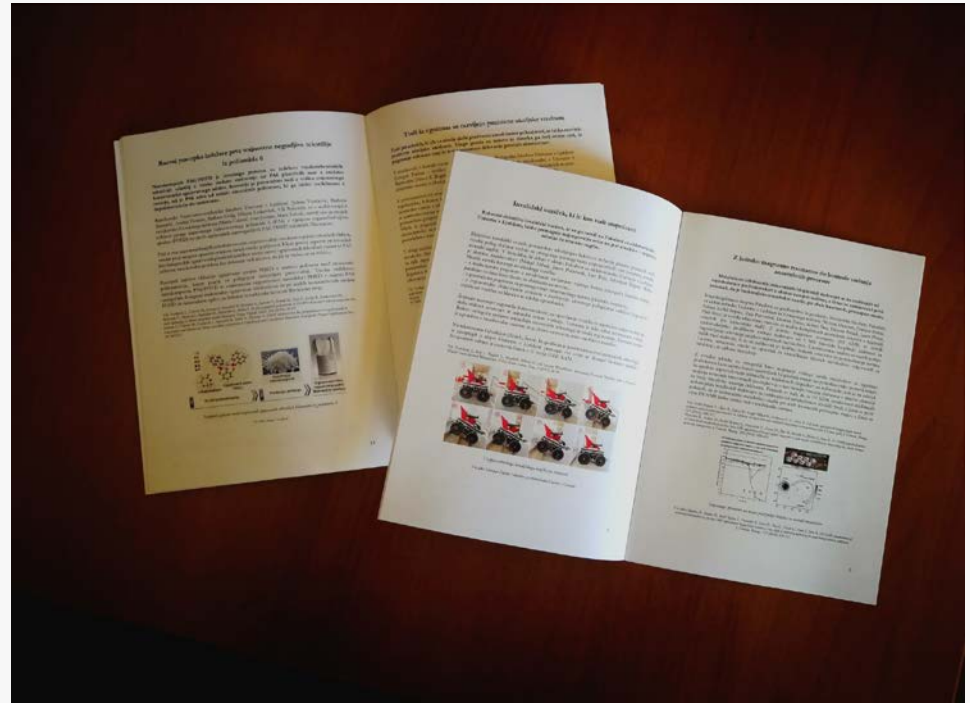

Editorial

Researchers uncover the cause of rising jackal populations across Europe

An international team of researchers that included Slovenian researcher Assia Prof. Dr. Mila Krušič (Department of Forestry and Renewable Forest Resources of the Biotechnical Faculty of the University of Ljubljana) was the first to study the relationship between Europe's two largest populations of the Canidae family – the wolf and the golden jackal. The results of this research were presented in two separate articles published in the international scientific journals *Nature Communications* and *Hybrid*.

Europe is currently experiencing the rapid growth of a new type of carnivore – the golden jackal. Over the past several decades, this species has spread rapidly across Europe, although the reason for the expansion has until late remained unknown. Two recent studies have now revealed the most likely cause for the expansion of jackal populations across Europe.

ERC Advanced Grant 2016 for established researchers awarded to Prof. Dr. Marta Verginella

Prof. Dr. Marta Verginella from Faculty of Arts of the University of Ljubljana was successful in her application for the ERC Advanced Grant 2016.

The Evaluation Panel for the Study of Human Past supported her five-year project entitled "Post War Transitions in Gendered Perspectives: The Case of the North Eastern Adriatic Region". The success of Prof. Dr. Marta Verginella's success is best illustrated by the fact that the European Research Council (ERC) will finance only 231 research projects selected from among 2,400 international applications for the implementation of this research project.



Slovenian Scientists Discovered a New Chemical Reaction Mechanism for the Formation of Carbon-Carbon Bonds

Researchers at the University of Ljubljana's Faculty of Chemistry and Chemical Technology led by Janusz Kikulić, have discovered a new reaction mechanism for the formation of carbon-carbon bonds. Their work has been published in the prestigious *Nature Communications* journal and involves by far the most important method of forming carbon-carbon bonds. The method is key to many syntheses of active ingredients at an industrial scale, including the active ingredients for treating Parkinson's, Alzheimer's and other neurodegenerative diseases.

Outstanding results for University of Ljubljana of the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Individual Fellowships call

Within this year's Horizon2020 Marie Skłodowska-Curie Individual Fellowships (MSCA IF) call, the University of Ljubljana, as a host institution, received funding for two highly talented foreign researchers to work on their project ideas.

Two-year funding for the successful project proposal has been granted to Dr. Guilhem Poy in collaboration with Prof. Dr. Slobodan Zimmer from the Faculty of Mathematics and Physics of the University of Ljubljana. Dr. Poy came to our university from the École Normale Supérieure de Lyon in France where he defended his doctoral thesis in 2017. Under the OPTOSOL project, by merging knowledge of photonics and physics of soft matter they are seeking for new ways of guiding light by means of chiral birefringent media such as cholesteric liquid crystals. The project aims to create a comprehensive model of optical solitons in chiral birefringent media and to develop methods for manipulating optical solitons with topological solitons, which are localized perturbations of the molecular orientation field. Their theoretical and numerical modelling will also be supported through collaboration with the experimental group for physics, optics and photonics of soft matter at the University of Colorado in Boulder.

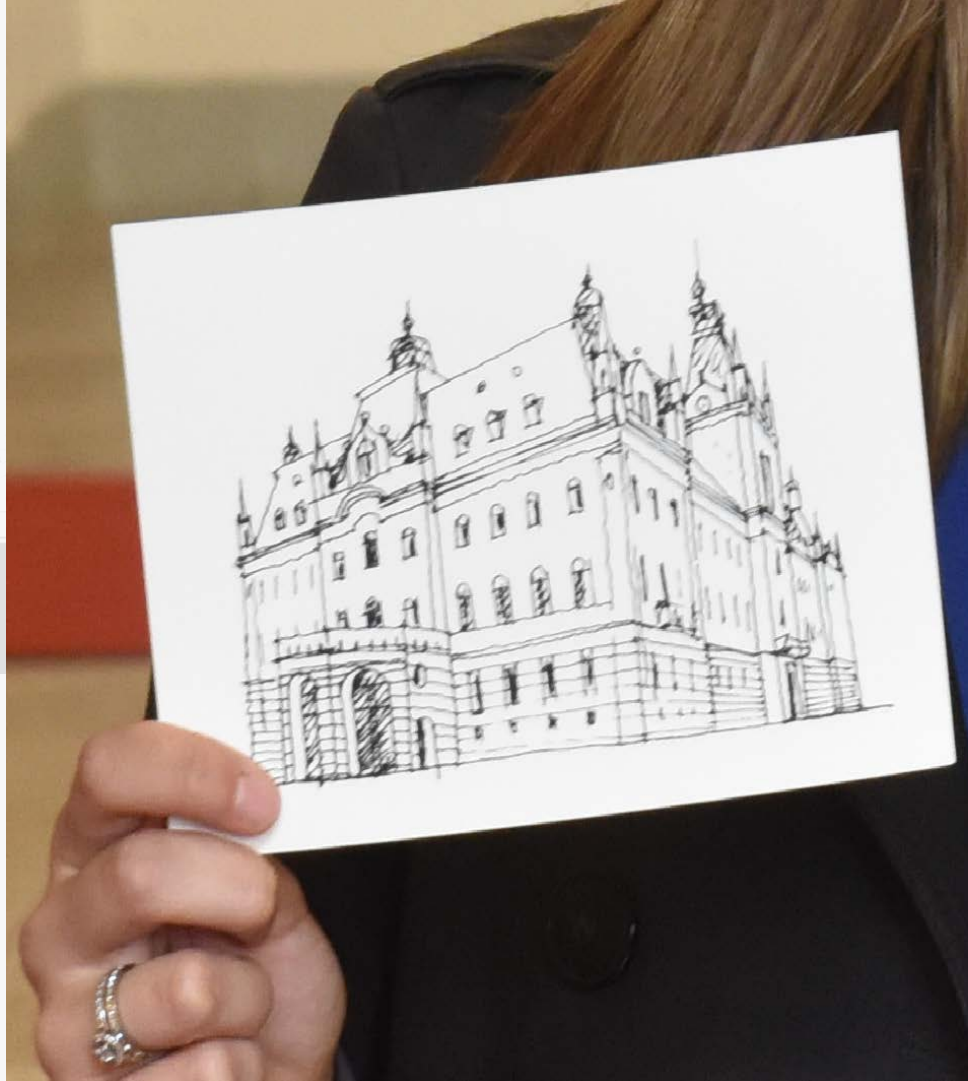

The first Doctor of Science title was awarded by the UL in 1920 to Ms. Ana Mayer Kansky, doctor of science in chemistry.

- **Continuous and ever faster rise:**
- The first decade (1919 to 1929) - 20 to 25 doctors annually
- By the end of WW2 (1945) - 137 doctoral titles awarded in total
- 1969 (50th anniversary) - 1168 doctoral titles awarded
- **By 2010 - 8000 doctoral titles awarded**
- **10 000th doctor of science title awarded on 20th May 2015**
- **11 000th doctor of science title awarded in June 2017**

11860 promoted doctors of science (until 6 February 2020).

Doctoral School

In 2007, the UL established the Doctoral School, as a **coordinator for the comprehensive transformation** of doctoral studies in line with the Bologna reform. The transformation was carried out taking into account:

- 1) Changing doctoral education (more and different PHD students + internationalization)
- 2) **European principles** (importance of EUA CDE)
- 3) Rich research **experience and academic tradition** at the UL



UL Doctoral School

UL Strategy 2012-2020 – importance of Doctoral education (strengthening of Doctoral School)

Vice Rector for Science, UL Senat's Commission for Doctoral Studies, Head of Doctoral School and 6 members of professional staff

Within the Doctoral School - **Council of doctoral programme coordinators** who manage, coordinate and represent doctoral study programmes.

The council (an advisory body)

- cooperates with the UL members' senates, programme councils of interdisciplinary or joint doctoral study programmes and research institutes;
- stimulating uniform quality standards, cohesion and multidisciplinary.

UL Doctoral School

In a decade of existence, the Doctoral School's main goals were to support:

- high quality of doctoral education at the University of Ljubljana;
- visibility of UL doctoral programs in Slovenia, Europe and the world.

Main tasks:

- Maintains **standards for doctoral studies** across disciplines through regulations and codes of practice.
- Provides a range of **support services**.
- Forms proposals and supports **strategic developments** (Doctorate in Arts, national standards of doctoral education, collaboration with research institutes).
- Coordinates **international cooperation in doctoral education**.

Doctoral Study Programs at UL

21 doctoral study programmes:

- 7 interdisciplinary programs: Biosciences, Biomedicine, Environmental Protection, Statistics, Humanities and Social Sciences, Materials Science and Engineering, Built Environment.

Quality Criteria for Doctoral Studies

All criteria for quality assurance and quality control accepted for other levels of education need to be respected. In addition, some specifics in doctoral studies need additional quality measurements.

Specific for doctoral studies at UL:

- Criteria for **mentors/supervisors**
- Criteria for course **coordinators and lecturers**
- Doctoral **committees**
- Strict requirement for doctoral students to **publish results** of their research



Principles of Doctoral Studies at UL

- The greatest significance of **research** in doctoral programs
- **Interdisciplinary approach** where possible
- **Critical mass** of students and staff
- **Generic skills** training
- Promotion of **student and staff mobility**
- **Quality assurance**



Principles of Doctoral Studies at UL – Rules

- 1) The same study conditions for doctoral students of all disciplines were accepted at institutional level and were published in the university document (first edition 2008).
- 2) [Rules of Doctoral Studies at the UL](#) (27th June 2017) apply to all doctoral study programmes.

Grant life cycle management – from concept to completion

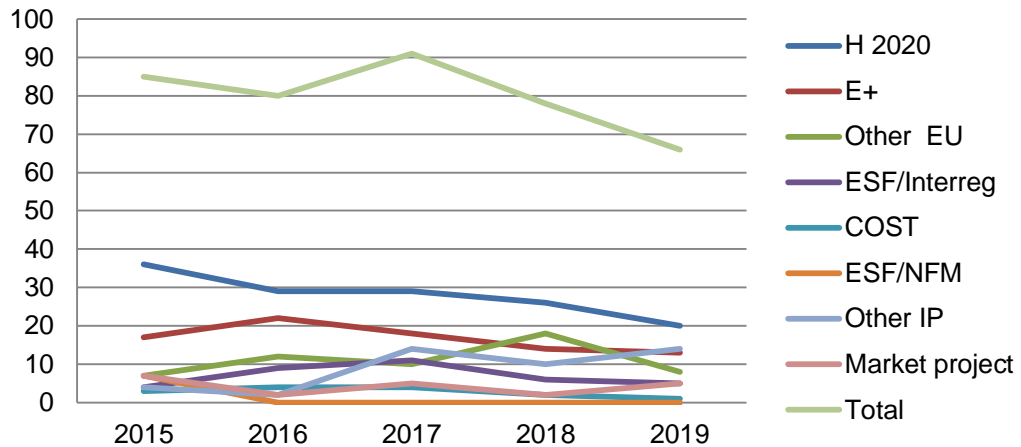
- Each phase of the grant life cycle has its own set of exact requirements for reporting, accounting, administration and management.
- **“pre-award”** phase of the lifecycle includes searching for funding, developing proposals and working with internal/international teams on grant applications, tracking the approval process for grant submissions, managing commonly requested information for grant applications, managing forms and policies, developing the proposal and budget, providing background information and documentation for audit reports, assisting in obtaining or providing institutional approval signatures, and solving submission problems.
- **“post-award”** phase are made up of project start up, documentation, award management, grant and contract analysis, effort certification as well as award close-out and end of project reporting.
- All reports must be accurate, complete, and submitted on time.

Pre-award phase

(before and during submission)

- Announcement of new EU/international calls (each week)
- Publishing all calls at intranet
- Each researcher may create his/her own tailor made search at “Research Professional”
<https://www.researchprofessional.com/0/rr/home>
- Publishing up-to date administrative and financial data (balance sheet, FIF, LEF, list of on-going projects, list of applications, description of institution, timesheets for different type of grants, etc.) at intranet (twice a year)
- Strategic advice – consortium and project set-up
- Writing and reviewing – matching proposal to call conditions (reading guidelines, downloading forms templates from F&TP- **Single Electronic Data Interchange Area (SEDIA)**), structuring impact and management section, reviewing and editing of the proposal, logo and layout design
- Organizational support – making timelines, distributing tasks, collecting partners' information and their input, facilitating meetings, advising on budget setup, communicating with other support offices (HR office and Accounting office-AO)
- Administrative and technical support – preparing and uploading all administrative forms (administrative and financial data), providing a description of institution and assisting in preparing CV in terms of ‘excellency’, etc.)

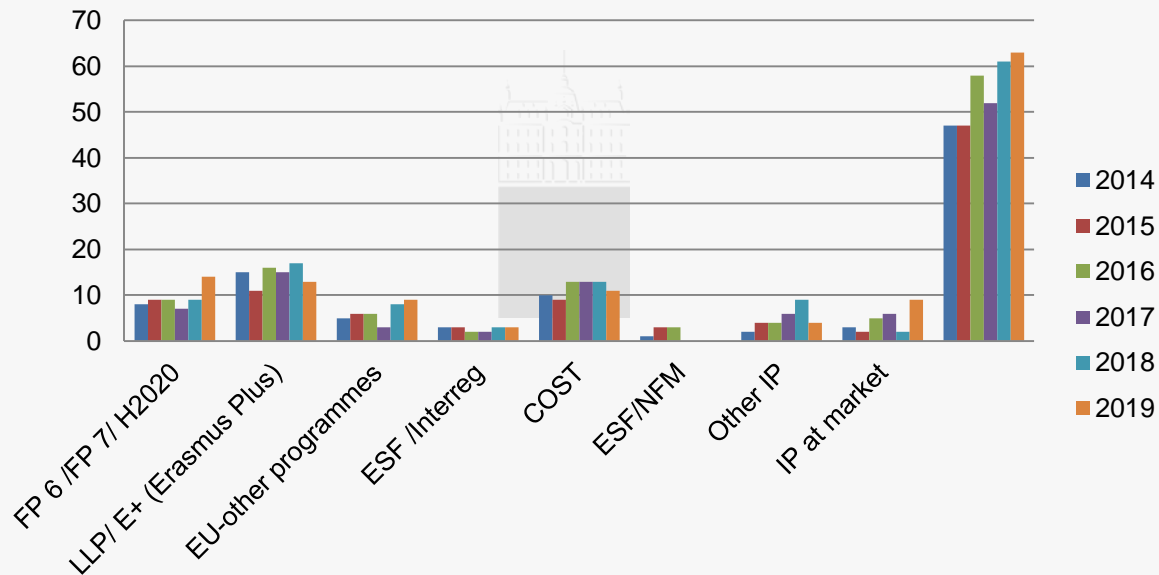

Post-award phase

- Strategic advice – processing feedback on proposal, preparing strategy for re-submission, communication with Grant-holder (partnership projects)
- Organizational support – distributing tasks, establishing research team-member and their input, coordinating signatures for both grant and consortium agreements, aligning budgetary requirements, communicating with the Commission/or Grant-holder
- Reviewing – answering questions (incl. financial, legal), structuring and reviewing documentation (description of action, re-shaping of budget, tasks, etc.)
- Financial and legal management – reporting, communicating with other internal support offices (HR and AO), communicating with funding agencies, grant-holders and/or PI, close communicating with internal PI/research team (technical and financial report should be matched)-meeting every 3 months, planning and reviewing financial data; ex-ante approval of all orders/eligible costs (staff, travel, sub-contracting, equipment, and others) through electronic system; assisting in preparing time-sheets, public purchasing, contracts with different type of external suppliers (goods, works, services) etc.
- Conducting and assisting in external auditing.

Challenges and Pitfalls

- Decentralisation of UL, fragmentation, lack of information and cohesion between UL members
- Mobility of students: declining trend in number of outgoing students, integration of incoming students, accommodation issue, sufficient offer of the English-taught courses
- Degree students: lack of administrative support for foreign degree students
- Joint and double degrees (preparation, different national rules and regulations, accreditation, implementation, financing,)
- Adaptation to new rapidly changing information channels

- Tutoring and Buddy system
- Increasing the number of the administrative staff abroad

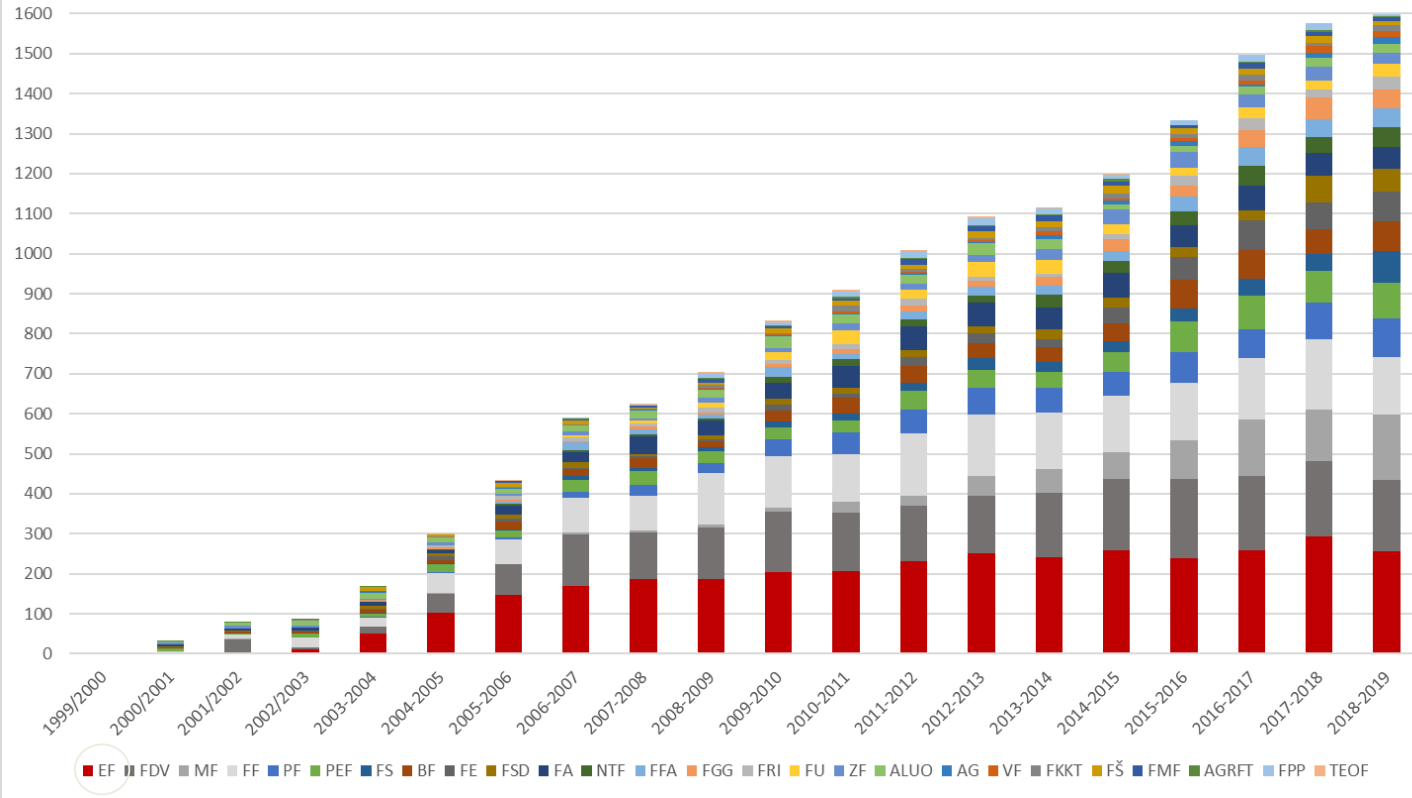

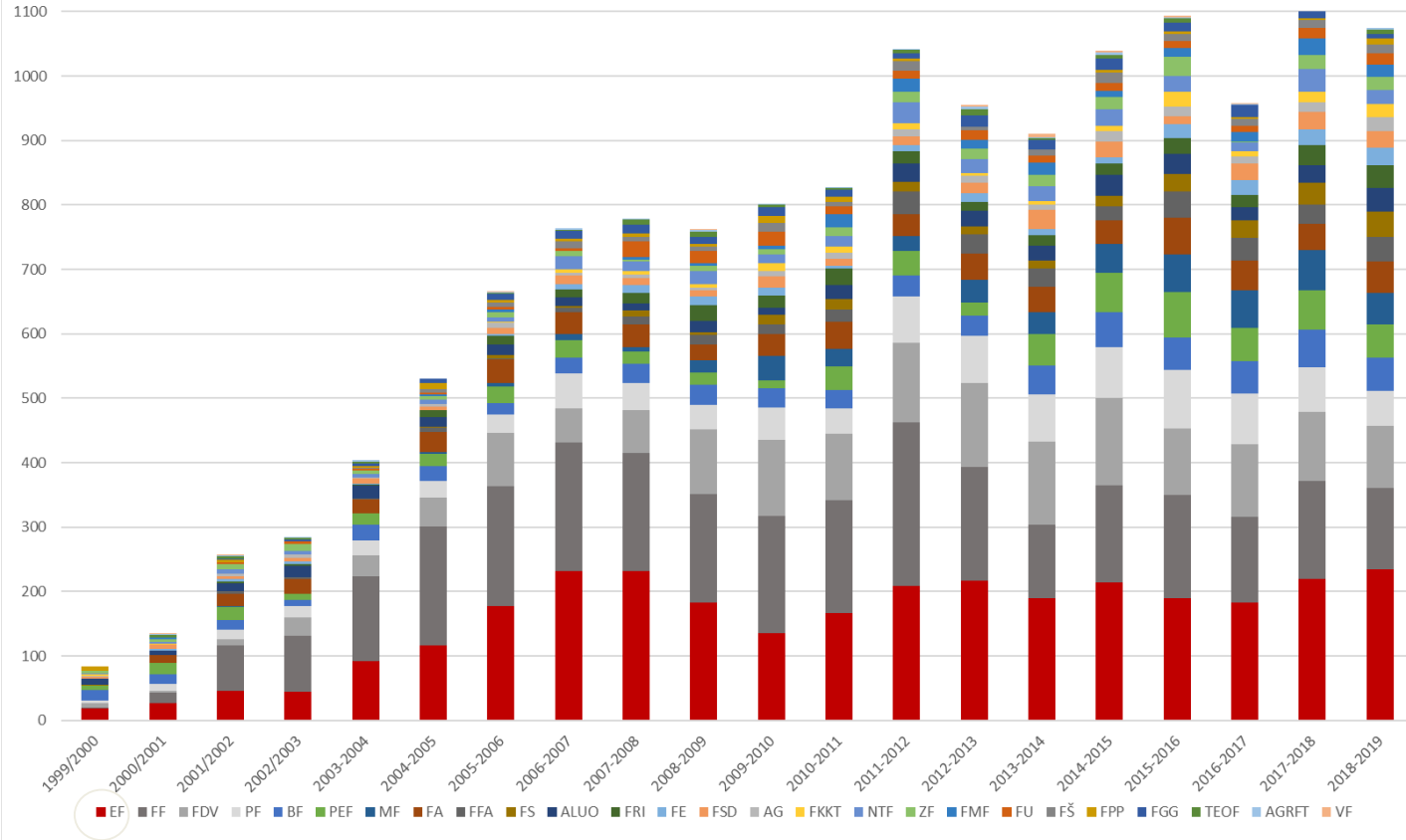
